Each month I will be asking the students to read a book from different genres. The students may find books from the school library, county library, class library, or from home. Then they will create a book report from the following ideas:

- Make a poster that will advertise this book. This must include the title of the book, author and illustrator, a picture or drawing of one scene from the book, and a short summary of the story.
- Create a book cover that includes the title of the book, author, illustrator, and a picture or drawing for the cover. The book cover must have flaps that fold around the cover of the book. On these flaps write a short summary of an exciting part of the book. Leave out the ending. On the back of the book cover create another picture of a scene or collection of scenes in the book to interest others in reading the book.
- Create an accordion book that tells about your book with pictures and words. Include the title, author, and illustrator on the first frame of the accordion book.
- Make a video commercial advertising the book. Include the book title, author, and illustrator in your video. You may create a scene from your book, or do a dramatic reading from the book, while video taping pictures from the illustrations that go along with the reading.
- Create a radio commercial using sound effects to dramatize the story or do a dramatic reading from the story. Remember the title, author, and illustrator in your commercial.
- If you have another creative idea, please discuss it with me before you do the project. Pop up book, collage, or
