- Identify the elements of art in objects in nature, in the environment, and in works of art emphasizing line, color, shape, and form.
- Recognize & describe patterns found in the environment & in works of art.
- Use lines, shapes & forms to make patterns.
- Use lines to express feelings.
- Make a collage.
- Create a three dimensional form.
- Look at and discuss various works of art.
- Look at and draw something used every day.
- Describe how and why they made a work of art.
- Describe what is seen in a work of art & use appropriate art vocabulary.
