

# Math 3 - Mrs. Lindberg

This class is designed to meet the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade level math standards. Some key concepts we will be addressing are:

Place value of whole numbers to 10,000

Addition & subtraction of whole numbers between 0-10,000

Multiplication and division of whole numbers by a single digit

Memorization of multiplication facts 0-10

The relationship between whole numbers, simple fractions & decimals

The commutative & associative properties of multiplication

Appropriate units of measurement

Properties of & the relationship between plane & solid geometric objects

Collecting, representing, & analyzing numerical and categorical data

Making predictions in simple probability situations

Making reasonable estimations

**I will assign homework every Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday.** There will be no homework on Fridays. Usually the homework will be to complete the Side B of each day's worksheet. Occasionally I will assign fact pages or worksheets from other sources. I do not collect homework until the day it is due. Then if you ask to see your child's homework each evening she can show it to you, even if it was already completed.

Students need to be well grounded in both their addition and subtraction facts, through sums of twenty. Multiplication facts will follow. I have extra timed tests I can provide your child to practice at home in all operations.
