

# Set Design Elective: Mrs. Lindberg

Welcome to Set Design! This class is created to give you successful experiences working as a team to create set pieces for RSA's musical, ***The Lion the Witch & the Wardrobe***.

**My class rules are as follows:**

1. **Be respectful of me, your artwork, each other, & your materials.**
2. **Work hard.**
3. **Be safe.**
4. **Clean up promptly and diligently!**

Please keep in mind that creating set pieces is an interactive process. Student's ideas, skills, and enthusiasm can take us many different directions. This class is also different from other art electives in the fact that we are creating a group project, not individual pieces. Students will be evaluated on the following criteria:

1. Cooperation and teamwork.
2. Effort (Including clean-up!)
3. Craftsmanship.
4. Creative problem solving and skill.

I expect students to behave in a manner consistent with RSA's school rules. Talking is OK as long as it is school appropriate and hopefully work related. Talking is not allowed during my teaching time. I expect all conversations to not interfere with class work.

Once we start painting we will be painting with latex paints. **No horseplay is allowed. Clean up is mandatory.** I encourage you to bring your own paint shirt when we get to this point. Once we begin painting, come to class dressed to paint each session. Even when you are being careful, paint can get on your shoes, socks, pants, skirts and shirts. Do not get a new brush or go to a new color until you have washed out your previous brush completely. Work calmly, be aware of where you are and be aware of others. If you spill, clean up immediately with a wet rag. If it is a big spill let me know.
