Minutes were distributed from September 19, 2008 meeting. Motion to adopt was made by Anna Tyrrell, and was seconded by Jackie Reger.

Directors' Report: Margaret Johnson

- LEED Report was given. Both RSA and RSAII will remain at their current sites through this school year and next school year 2009/2010.
- Health Policy Committee: A sign-up sheet was distributed seeking 10 volunteers to serve on this committee which will address new health policies.
- PTC Flyers were distributed, and Mrs. Johnson asks that parents pass them on to other families who may have an interest in attending RSA.

Treasurer's Report: Devon Googins reported that Scrip card sales to date have collected more than \$1000. Snack Cart is generally collecting up to \$100 per week.

Governing Board Report: Colleen Tweed reviewed the role of the Governing Board. There will be a formal meeting next week, and there was a "special meeting" last week to discuss options regarding the RSA Charter. Options included grandfathering in on the Shasta High School charter, re-chartering as a grade school, and rolling together the charters of RSA and RSAII. We will continue using our current physical space regardless of which option is chosen. Reportedly the Governing Board also approved the hiring of new staff members.

Old Business:

- Snack Cart: There is not currently a snack cart operating at RSAII. We are still seeking a volunteer coordinator for the snack cart at the main site, as well as seeking help manning the cart on Tuesday and Thursday afternoon. Contact Jeanie Carlon if interested.
- PTC Meeting Location; PTC will meet in the RSAII Library on the second Friday of the month at 8:30 am (except for April, when the meeting will take place on April 3rd due to Spring Break).
- Scrip Card sales: Cards will be available for purchase at RSAII beginning 11/08. They are already available for purchase at the Main RSA campus. Lori Cahill heads the Scrip card sales. Peggy defined the difference between the Scrip cards and the E-Scrip program. The Scrip cards are gift-cards which can be purchased individually and used either as gifts, daily use, etc. Lori is planning a Holiday Blitz in December, at which time a wide variety of gift cards will be available for purchase at pick-up locations on both campuses.

This helps those who are organizing the event tremendously. Heidi also encourages everyone to purchase their tickets for the event.

New Business:

- Family Dance: We are hoping to have a Family Dance for the whole school this spring. It will occur at the RSAIL site as the Multi-purpose room will be available for use. We will be looking for a coordinator and volunteers for this event in the spring.
